First EU Mayors Digital Assembly 15 June 2023 9.00 – 11.00 The Square, Brussels

Introduction:

On 15th of June the Living-in.EU movement organises its first EU Mayors Digital Assembly in Brussels, in the framework of the Brussels Urban Summit 2023.

The Mayors' Digital Assembly is the political advisory body which provides strategic orientation to the Living-in.EU movement. The Mayors Digital Assembly is co-chaired by Mayor Seppo Määttä city of Oulu and Mayor Lluïsa Moret Sabidó city of Sant Boi de Llobregat. The annual event will be the occasion for mayors, regional presidents and other signatories to debate the political priorities of the movement and to launch new strategic coordinated actions to tackle some key challenges and advance the twin green and digital transformation of EU cities and communities.

Programme:

The first EU Mayors Digital Assembly will discuss key priorities in two high-level panels: 'Leading by example' and 'the city that leaves no one behind'. In the first panel, city mayors and regional ministers discuss the opportunities for cities to act as open urban platforms for testing new technologies and developing new and better services and solutions such as local digital twins and local data platforms to be upscaled at regional, National, and European level. The second panel will discuss concrete collaborative practices to overcome digital divide through experimental learning and facilitating access to local public services. The panel discussions are also the opportunity to launch cooperative and ad-hoc actions to be developed during the next 2-years mandate.

The event will also be the occasion to launch new tools and collaborative initiatives such as the LORDIMAS, to measure the digital maturity of cities and regions.
